TRAVEL INSURANCE - PLEASE READ!

Every year, someone has to cancel their trip for one reason or another, and unfortunately, it is not always possible to find a suitable replacement at the last minute, and the Club is not always in a position to refund all the money. Rarely, but surely, someone is injured or becomes sick during the trip and incurs significant medical expenses. The travel insurance can offset these risks at the cost between 5 percent and 15 percent of the total cost of your trip.

Many products "waive" pre-existing conditions and offer additional "Cancel For Any Reason" coverage, if you purchase coverage within 21 days of your deposit, but only then.

As part of our group ski package booked with Merit Ski Vacation, we've been offered an option to purchase Allianz Visitors to Canada Package Age 0-89 Travel Insurance. Contact trip leader for additional information.

- Medical Coverage (up to \$200,000 USD): Premiums are as follows (based on age and per person): 35-39: \$32.00; 40-54: \$39.00; 55-59: \$41.00; 60-64: \$49.00; 65-69: \$58.00.
- Cancellation (up to \$900.00 USD) with Unlimited Interruption: Premiums are as follows (based on age and per person): 0-54: \$85.00; 55-59: \$86.00; 60-64: \$95.00; 65-69: \$102.00; 70-74: \$114.00.
